The Forest Park of Mas Ratés and Can Trius, the Remolar-Filipines Natural Reserve and the Sant Ramon mountain sanctuary are natural spaces which form a rich environmental and cultural area right in the middle of a Metropolitan Area.




# WITH ITS GARDEN AND PRODUCT




# WITH ITS SHOPPING OPTIONS





#### **Atrium Viladecans**

A unique space which brings together sport and cultural services all in one location. Its cultural programme is considered one of the most varied and interesting throughout Catalonia.



#### Torre-roja

A mediaeval building, from the 13<sup>th</sup> century, reformed and expanded throughout the first decades of the 20th c. Property of the Burguès family (13th-16th c.), it passed to the Alòs (18th c.) and finally at the start of the 20<sup>th</sup> century to Mercè Pratmarsó.



#### <u>Ca n'Amat – Museu de Viladecans</u>

Building from the end of the 18th century, reformed in the middle and end of the 19th century, representative of the well-off rural bourgeoisie.




#### Can Modolell - Casa de la Vila

A building with neo-Gothic inspiration built in 1892 by the architect Josep Azemar at the request of the local property owner, Magdalena Modolell i Freixas.



### Torre del Baró

A mediaeval building, the seat of the Barcelona-based line of the Burguès, the family that owned the property within the city limits of Viladecans throughout the 13th-16th c.
